- Return to Buford High School on Saturday, April 27 between 10:00-11:00 AM

Dress Code: Universal created and enforces a special dress code for this event that may be different than some high school dress codes. Universal Grad Bash is a special school event, so the dress code is enforced. Proper dress/attire for Universal Grad Bash for students and chaperones is required. All outfits must remain intact for the entire event and for the City Walk pre-party. Students and chaperones not meeting these guidelines will not be admitted. Participants will be asked to adhere to the guidelines if not dressed appropriately.

Acceptable Attire for Girls

- Dresses, skirts, capris or Bermuda shorts no shorter than mid-thigh
- Casual pants (including jeans)
- Casual blouses and tops with sleeves at least 3 inches wide
- Comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress sandals, boots and flip-flops)
- Purses no larger than 8.5" x 5.5" (size of a half sheet of notebook paper)

Acceptable Attire for Guys

- Casual pants or shorts (including khakis and jeans) secured at waist
- Shirts with sleeves (golf/polo, dress and tee shirts), sport jackets, and dress suits
- Comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress shoes, boots and flip-flops)

Unacceptable for Anyone:

- Basketball shorts of any kind
- High school jerseys, clothing or accessories displaying high school name/letters, mascot or logos
- Sports team apparel of any kind (high school, college, group, club or professional)
- Clothing or accessories with area codes
- Hats
- Backpacks of any size, type or style (does not apply to chaperones)
- Clothing that is too tight or exposes excessive portions of the skin
- Clothing with holes, tearing or shredding
- Accessories that may be used as weapons (chains, spiked collars or belts, sharp objects, pendants or charms larger than 2 inches)
- Clothing with language or graphics that are obscene, offensive or suggestive of sexual, vulgar, drug, alcohol, or tobacco-related messaging
- Gang paraphernalia, jewelry, tattoos, clothing which display, suggest or provoke violence
